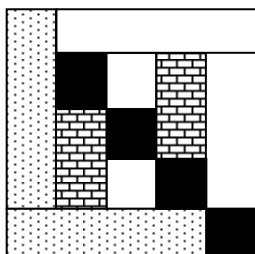


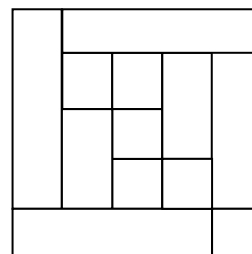
Bordered Nine-Patch







10 inch finished block

Put a border on a nine-patch and it takes on a new look. Such a simple block, it must have been used before, but I cannot find any references to it.



Colour the block on the right with the colours of your choice.



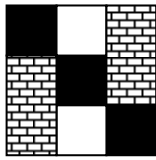
Fabric	Size	Number of pieces
	2 ½ inch square	2
	2 ½ by 6 ½ inches	1
	2 ½ by 8 ½ inches	1
	2 ½ by 4 ½ inches	2
	2 ½ by 8 ½ inches	2
	2 ½ inch square	4

Let's start building a rainbow of colours for this year:

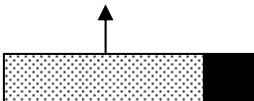
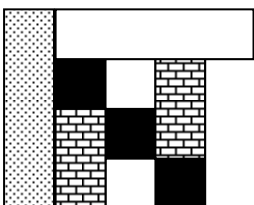
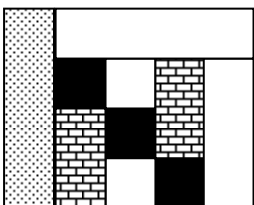
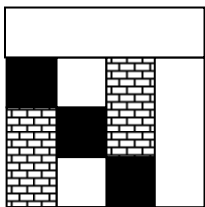
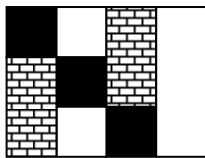
The colour of September is RED. You must have a piece of RED fabric in your block! Your other fabrics should blend/contrast accordingly.

Construction:

Using standard techniques - construct the centre nine-patch:



Now add the outside borders



Sew the last dark block to the right end of the last border strip before sewing the border to the nine-patch.

If you are making the sampler:

Four individual blocks, rotated make the first section of the sampler quilt.
