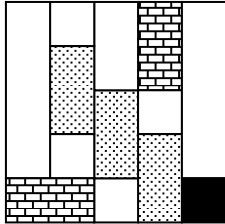


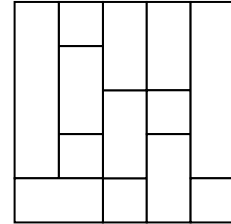
Bricks

10 inch finished block

A simple five patch block!









Colour the block on the right with the colours of your choice.



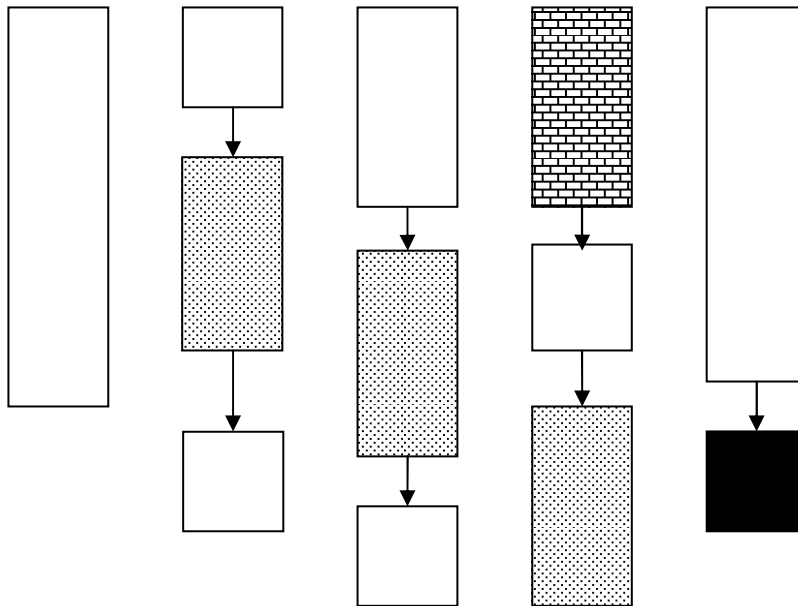
We have worked our way to Green in the colour wheel this month, so let's try for a mossy brick look - use the supplied fabric (or a mossy green fabric) for the background, and pick some nice clay brick colours for the bricks.

Cutting:

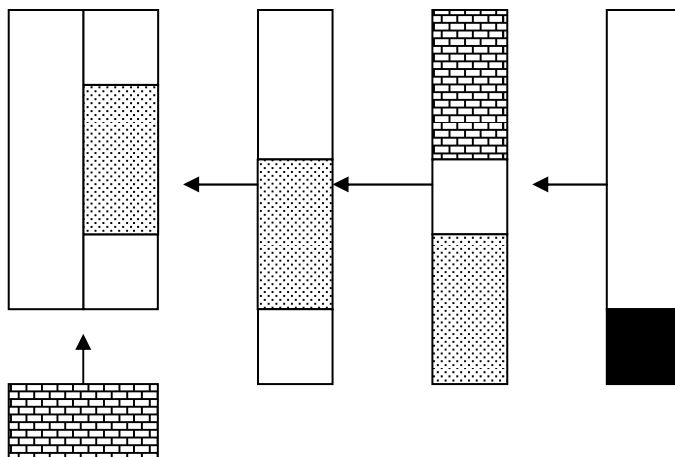
Fabric	Size	Number of pieces
	2 1/2 inch square	4
	2 1/2 by 4 1/2 inches	1
	2 1/2 by 8 1/2 inches	2
	2 1/2 by 4 1/2 inches	2
	2 1/2 by 4 1/2 inches	3
	2 1/2 inch square	1

Construction:

Most of this block can be pieced in vertical rows:



The first two verticals on the left are shorter - once they are sewn together - add the bottom patch. Then add the rows on the right



If you are making the sampler:

Four individual blocks, rotated make section of the sampler quilt.
